STUDENT TRANSFERRING FROM OTHER SCHOOLS:

(This fee is for transferring students only; it is NOT for new students to Irish Dance)

We are members of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha in Dublin, Ireland, the IDTANA N.E. Region INC. and the North American Irish Dance Teachers Assoc. This means that we are certified teachers and or adjudicators and must follow all of commission rules and regulations. One rule which we must make you aware of is that any new student coming into our school who previously took Irish dancing from another certified teacher must serve a six-month retraining period. This means he/she may not enter competitions during that period. A student who is leaving our school and chooses to go to another certified teacher must also serve a six-month retraining period. This rule does not affect students that have relocated to a new area, although many teachers recommend it. This rule is to ensure that a student will feel comfortable with their new material and style.
