

Entries

Entries for Bracken School Feis must be done through www.feisweb.com only and payment must be made through Paypal. No entries will be accepted via mail or refunded.

Competitor cards will be emailed to all approved paid in full entrants the week prior to the feis. This card should be printed out at home. Your competitor card will also be available for pick-up at the feis.

Entry Fees:

Solo - \$9.50/dance

Preliminary - \$35.00

Open - \$40.00

Feisweb - \$2.00

Maximum Family rate: \$125.00

(Not including \$20 admission, late fee or Feisweb charge)

Admission Fee: \$20 family – must be paid or entry will not be accepted.

Late Fee - \$10.00 per dancer, no changes day of the feis.

All fees must be paid for within 7 days of registering on Feisweb otherwise your entry will be deleted.

*** \$10 fee for any changes made to dances. Absolutely no changes after closing date or day of feis.**

The Feis Committee or Triton High School is not responsible for personal injury or harm to any competitor or spectator. By submitting an entry online at www.feisweb.com parent or legal guardian agrees to abide by rules governing the feis as listed on the NAFC website.

Soda Bread Competition #1001 - Entry for this competition is the donation of the Irish Bread that will become the property of the Feis Committee. Bread must be submitted to the baking committee by 11 AM day. Judging will take place at noon.

Rules for Feis:

1. All dancers, Beginners through Champions, are asked to wear modest black attire, NOT formal costumes.
 - a. Suggested attire is skirt, or skort, girls/ladies. Gents may wear long pants and shirt. No collared shirt or tie is necessary. Either long or short-sleeves are acceptable. Tops must meet the costume requirements set forth by the NAIDC (e.g., cover the collarbone). Branded attire (ie Nike, Adidas) should be small and discreet.
 - b. Girls/Ladies should wear black tights
2. No school branded attire on stage
3. No Wigs or hairpieces
4. No bling on any performance costumes, ie skirts, leotards, or shoe buckles.
5. Stud earrings only. No hoops or dangling earrings
